



Take Five Dogcare **requires** a current Rabies & Distemper Combination (DHPP) vaccine for all dogs receiving services. For your pet's own safety, we also strongly suggest your pup receives the Bordetella Vaccine. We will accept dogs for daycare, boarding, and grooming services without the Distemper Combination and Bordetella Vaccine; however, this is at the owner's risk. If you would like Take Five Dogcare to accept your dog for services, without proof of the Distemper Combination and Bordetella Vaccine, please review the following vaccine information and sign below.

Core Vaccines. Considered vital to all pets based on risk of exposure, severity of disease or transmissibility to humans. (Required for all dogs at Take Five Dogcare)

- Rabies Vaccine. Since rabies is an incurable disease that can also inflict humans, administering a rabies
 vaccine to your dog is required by law. A rabies vaccine is given when the dog is between 16-18 weeks of
 age. An additional injection is given after one year, after which boosters are given every one to three
 years.
- **Distemper Combination Vaccine** (DHPP or DHLPP). This vaccine covers diseases like Distemper Virus, Parvovirus, Adenovirus and Parainfluenza Virus in a single injection. This vaccination should be administered to the puppy after 6-8 weeks of age. A booster should also be given every 3-4 weeks, till the puppies are 16 weeks old. An additional injection is given after one year, after which boosters are given every one to three years.

Non-Core Vaccines (Strongly Recommended)

Bordetella Vaccine (Kennel Cough Vaccine). This vaccine fights against the bacteria called Bordetella
Bronchiseptica that causes kennel cough in dogs. It should be generally administered to all dogs that
come in contact with other dogs (during daycare, boarding, grooming, and/or training classes). It can be
taken either annually or semi-annually, depending on the requirement and the level of risk the dog is
exposed to.
